ENTRIES; Dressage tests \$20. Equitation/in hand/suitability \$12. Hunter/Jumper \$15. \$10 office fee per horse/rider pair. Submit entries on CSDEA Dressage entry form (no non-member or drug fees apply) or use RRF entry form. A current (2012) negative coggins test is required ,INCLUDE A COPY WITH ENTRY. Send entries and draw checks to show manager .Post entries rides added day of show as time permits---pre-entered horses only.Substitutions of class, rider or horse after closing considered at \$5. Ea.

REFUNDS; All fees refunded prior to closing with vet certificate only. No refunds if show must be cancelled. Management reserves the right to cancel due to unsafe weather conditions. NO REFUNDS AFTER CLOSING.

ATTIRE; Riding attire need not be formal. Approved helmet and footwear are required at all times. Safety vests required for Cross Country.

ARENAS: Dressage tests will be ridden in a standard outdoor arena with sand or in a small indoor . Stadium jumping will be in a grass field.

AWARDS;Trophy, Ribbons through 6th place.Classes may be combined/split as needed.

STABLING; Limited stabling is available on the grounds at \$25. per day (\$10 refunded if you clean your own stall) VERY LIMITED Overnight stabling \$40. No refund with o/n stabling. Priority given to distance traveled.
